

# Sample Itinerary



## Day 1

Travel from Managua airport to group hotel for an orientation and then visit the community for a welcoming ceremony.



## Days 2-7

Travel by bus to the worksite to help construct a rural school or educational room. Work alongside local community members digging dirt, mixing concrete, laying brick, or cutting rebar. Deepen friendships with school children through crafts and games. Afternoon excursions to sites such as nature reserves, chocolate production plant, farmer and women's cooperatives, or activities like hiking, swimming, soccer and more. Evening reflections and cultural and historic presentations. The final day in community will include a farewell ceremony.



## Day 8

Travel to Mombacho Volcano, an inactive volcano with a cloud forest to hike or go zip lining. Overnight at hotel in the colonial town of Granada.



## Day 9

Swim and relax on a picturesque crater lake and visit the traditional artisan market in Masaya. Debriefing before departure to US or Canada.
